6. **Application process:**
 - a. Interests fill out and submit SBA Special Scholarship Program application by September 15th (for 2010 only).
 - b. A three-team committee reviews applications and selects participant.
 - c. Foundation Office notifies recipient
 - d. Selected candidate fills out SBA enrollment form.
 - e. Upon receipt of enrollment form OCPE requests funds transfer from Foundation Office.
7. **Selection process of recipient:**
 - a. Members of the selection committee review applicants and scores.
 - b. Members discuss candidates' scores and application.
 - c. Members select participant.
8. **Composition of selection committee:**
 - a. Scholarship donor designee
 - b. OCPE representative
 - c. College Designee
9. **Additional information regarding account:**
Donor to be informed of registration fee by January 31st of each year. Donor sends a donation in the registration amount to Foundation Office / Seattle Central Community College / 1701 Broadway / Seattle, WA 98122
10. **Number of recipients each year:** One
11. **Award Frequency:** Annually
12. **Award Amount:** Approximately \$2,195
